Has a cover page with the assessment title, your name, student number and word count. 2. Include a 'footer' on each page with your name, student number, unit code and page number. 3. 3 cm margins on all sides, 1.5 spaced text 4. Times New Roman; font size 12 5. CiteWrite APA style style referencing. Note it is a requirement that page numbers for in-text references are provided (see http://www.citewrite.qut.edu.au/). 6. As a general rule, postgraduate work should contain one new reference per 100 words (2000 word assignment should have a minimum of 20 references). 7. Be submitted in electronic format via Turnitin. 8. Aim to use references that are primarily peer-reviewed journal articles, published within the last five years.
Task description:	In this assessment item you will develop a supportive self-management plan based on a critical application of a chronic disease model for a person encountered in your clinical practice with a chronic health condition.

<p>What you need to do:</p>	<p>As one complete assignment you will provide an essay-format introduction, self-management plan in a table format and an essay-style conclusion.</p> <p>1) Essay Introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In 100-250 words, provide a brief introduction of what you intend to discuss in the essay including a brief description of the chronic health condition. - Identify and discuss a chronic disease model of care that will enable you to help the patient with self-management <p>2) Complete a tabled self-management plan which incorporates a critical application of a chronic disease model of care used to inform self-management, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Articulation of short and long-term goals. Goals need to be realistic, achievable and patient-orientated, and clearly linked to a chronic disease model of care. • Identification and critical examination of specific strategies or interventions to support self-management. • Identification of the tasks/actions necessary to complete each strategy, as well as who will perform these tasks. • Examination of the effectiveness of the self-management plan (i.e. how the achievement of goals will be evaluated). <p>3) Essay Conclusion</p> <p>In 100-250 words, summarize the content of the essay, emphasising the most significant factors that must be considered in the nursing and patient- self management of the health problem you have discussed.</p>
