### Structure of an Evidence Implementation Plan

#### Title:

• Succinct but descriptive

## Summary or brief overview of plan

## **Background and literature review:**

- Is there a current problem or is there evidence for better practice?
- Does literature identify barriers and/or suggest how these might be overcome (e.g. frameworks and models?

### Aims of the implementation:

- What improvement or outcomes are expected?
- How will these outcomes be evaluated?

#### Identification of stakeholders, champions and targets

• Who will be involved and when?

#### **Identification of barriers**

What or who might hinder the plan?

## Significance of the project:

• Why is this practice change necessary?

# Method of knowledge transfer: Planned staging of implementation activities

- How will barriers be addressed?
- How will stakeholders be involved?

### **Proposed evaluation**

• How will results be evaluated?

# **Ethical or resource implications:**

 What are sources of potential harm to clients or disruption to practice and what measures will be taken to avoid these?

### **Budget**

• What costs are associated with the implementation

### **Justification**

• What is the cost-benefit to the organization and to the client in improved health care and outcomes?

### Time line

 How long will the implementation take (including the evaluation of outcomes)?
