Required Format for your Assignment

The Journal critique is required to be in word format and should have two sections;

I. SUMMARY

- This should be only a factual summary paragraph(s) of the article and should be no longer than a page.
- The summary should be a synopsis of key parts of the research including but not limited to Study Design, Study Population, Primary Outcome, Primary exposure, Research Question, Key Findings, Conclusion
- In your summary you should include key statistics pertaining to the research question
- There should be no critique or commentary included in this section
- It should be written in paragraph form; NO BULLETS points

II. CRITIQUE

- Your critique should be written in paragraph form and should be exactly that, a critique; No summarizing and No bullet points!
- In writing the critique you should assume that I have read the article and that all matters that you wish to address in the
 critique have been mentioned in some way in the summary; this should reduce you repeating issues already presented in
 the summary
- You critique should consider critique elements for all the sections of the article but for the most part most critiquing should focus on the methods
- You should have a minimum of 5 points to critique (3 must be critiques of the methods section), but you are not restricted this minimum.
- The 3 points selected from the methods should be discussed exhaustively considering key aspects of good research
 methodology that are applicable to the issue raised. These include potential for bias, internal validity or external validity of
 the study
- The end of your critique should have a summary statement stating whether you think the research presented was Good,
 Poor or Fair evidence
