Milestones One through Four helped you complete most of the content for your 10-slide presentation. Throughout this course, you were also prompted to incorporate your instructor's feedback and turn your written milestones into a presentation. If you have not done so yet, you will now organize all parts into your presentation. You may need to modify your original content into a form useful in a presentation, including the speaker notes and the visual slides. Here is a checklist of all of the elements you should have at this time:

- Background:** Have you provided background on the public health issue?

- Epidemiology**
 - Patterns, Causes, and Effects:** Have you analyzed the epidemiological patterns, causes, and effects of the health issue in the population?
 - Social Determinants:** Have you described the social determinants associated with the issue?
 - Known Disparities:** Have you described the known disparities associated with the issue?

- Public Health Interventions**
 - Analyze:** Have you analyzed two public health interventions? Including theoretical basis?
 - Intervention Strategies:** Have you explained the level of intervention?
 - Social Determinants:** Have you explained how the interventions address the social determinants and disparities you previously identified?

- Public Health Response**
 - Organizations:** Have you described the public health organizations involved at both national and local levels?
 - Subdisciplines:** Have you identified specific subdisciplines involved in responding to the issue?
 - Services:** Have you explained the public health services involved in the response to the issue?
